- This December we gathered to celebrate the third anniversary of the opening of our Catheterization Lab with its 6-bed recovery room and Intensive Care Unit backup. Since its inception, our expert team of doctors and nurses have saved over 600 lives of patients presenting with life-threatening conditions.

Our participants will travel throughout the Holy Land to mark months of fundraising for essential, life-saving equipment: namely, a CT scanner for the first dedicated Stroke Department in the Nazareth area.
