The Nazareth Hospital EMMS

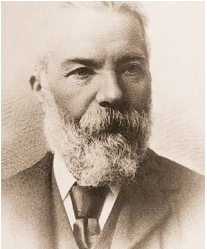
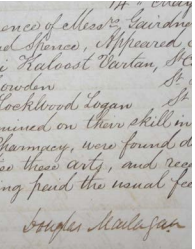
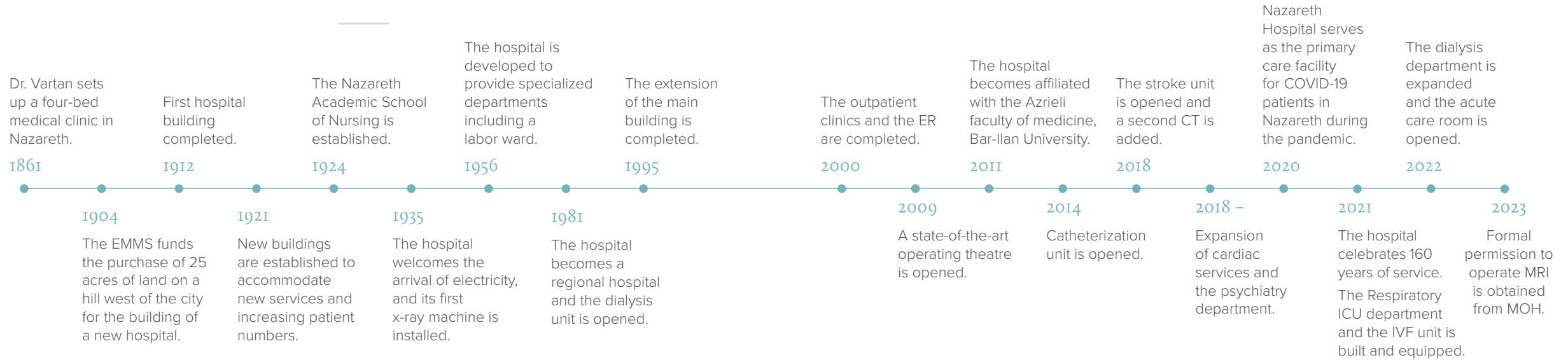
The Nazareth Hospital, commonly known as the ‘English Hospital’, is the main trauma and acute care center and teaching hospital in the Nazareth area and neighboring villages.

Founded in 1861 by Dr. Kaloost Vartan as a four-bed clinic, the hospital serves a catchment area of more than 500,000 people today.

The hospital offers specialized services that are not available in other local hospitals, such as a catheterization unit, stroke unit, fortified respiratory intensive care unit, pediatric surgery and mental health services.

Today, the Nazareth Hospital is a WHO hospital promoting health and well-being in Northern Israel, within a predominantly Arab community.

Our History

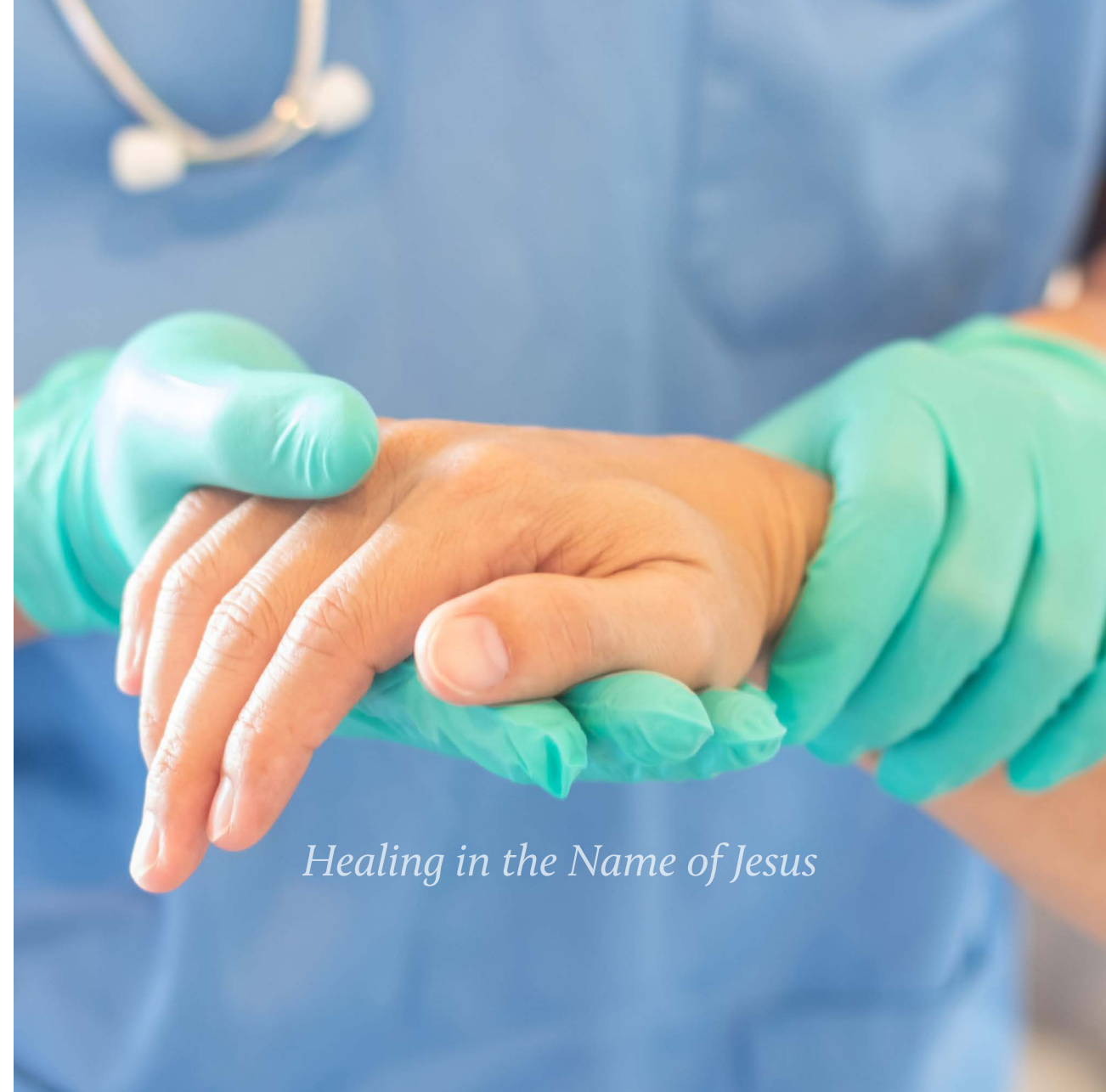


Our Vision: Empowering the community through teaching, research, clinical and professional excellence.

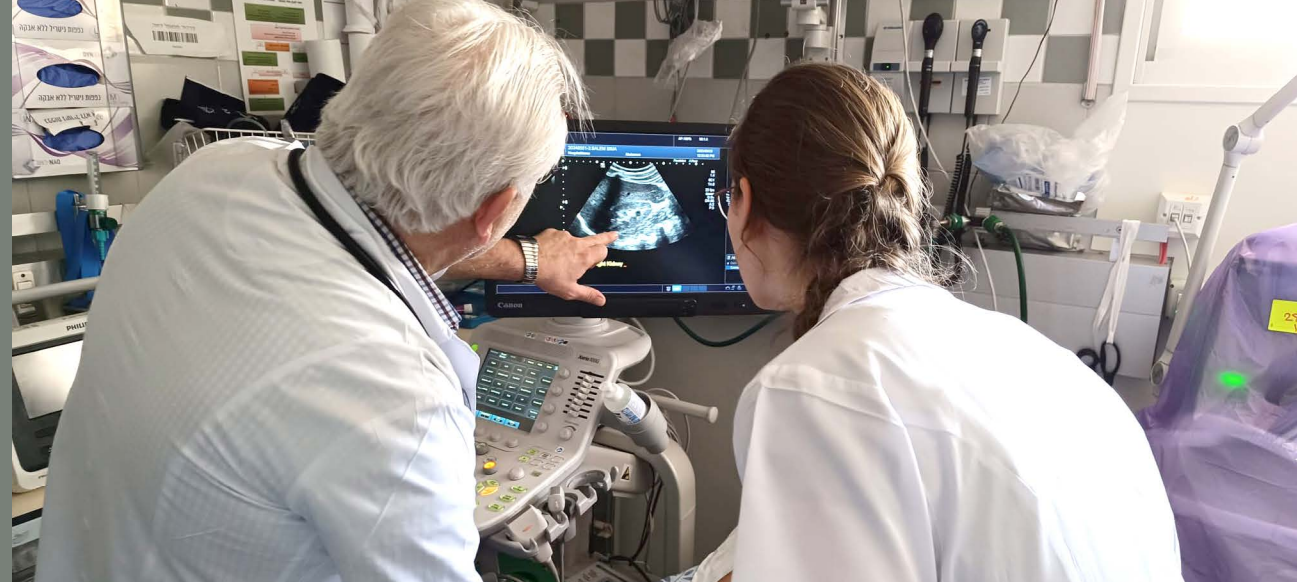
